If the governance committee decides to increase the number of directors, it would be ideal to ensure that the rolling three-year term schedule be kept in mind, to ensure we have a somewhat balanced number of board members concluding their term each year. In previous years, the ideal number of total board members each term is 7-8.

Treasurer Nomination:

Mr. Stowers reviewed the nomination process and stated it would be an informal or formal process. Committee members brought up the possibility of a member from the Finance committee to serve as Treasurer.

Discuss Nomination Form:
